Rule of Thumb

The more people involved, the more activities to keep everyone entertained. The smaller the group size the less activities to keep the costs manageable.

Working with Large Numbers

Clay Pigeon Shooting is the only activity that can accommodate 2 – 200 people without the need for another activity alongside. All other activities once you get over 15 people generally need another activity to keep groups sizes manageable.

Entertaining Clients

When entertaining clients we consider it important to bear in mind that unless you know them well, mud, water, over-exertion and making a fool of people doesn't go down well!
